- 1. No age discrimination. Ages 6 to 106 can enjoy collecting stamps.
- 2. It is possible to collect stamps with almost no investment. \$20 is all that is needed to get started, and probably a lot less will work well.
- 3. No gender discrimination. Boys and girls. Men and women.
- 4. No discrimination by religion or native language. Anybody in the world can collect stamps.
- 5. It can take up a little amount of space. Beginners can easily store it a medium size box.
- 6. It is creative. Each stamp collector gets to collect what he or she wants, and in the way he or she wants.
- 7. It is safe. Don't have to worry about anything worse than a paper cut.
- 8. & 9. It can be done when it is raining outside. It can be done when it is dark outside.
- 10. There is a huge amount of literature available regarding stamp collecting.
- 11. It is a great inter-generational activity. Grandparents with grandchildren work well!
- 12. It opens up the whole world to the collector famous places, events, people, etc.
